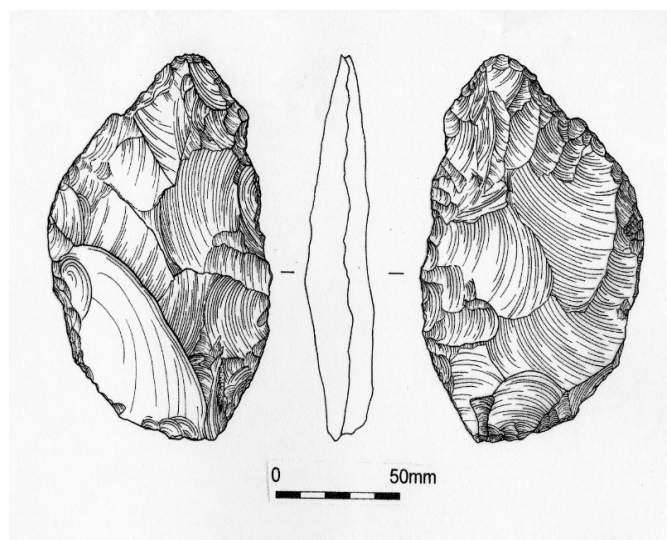
ARCHAEOLOGICAL ILLUSTRATION:

FLINT and STONE ARTEFACTS

STUDY DAY

Saturday, 21st April 2018, 10am-4pm

Tutor: Jane Russell B.A., M.A. (former Senior Illustrator at Archaeology South-East)



The day will cover basic flint drawing in pencil, using traditional archaeological conventions. These drawings can be used for later inking up by pen or drawing through a computer programme (neither inking up nor computer programmes are covered in the course). The course will start with an introductory tutorial, followed by students experimenting with their own flint drawings, and then later in the day we will draw stone artefacts. The course is suitable for all abilities, whether beginners or those with some experience who wish to brush up on their skills.

Equipment for the course

Please do not buy any expensive drawing equipment, as the tutor will provide the basic drawing equipment, but if you do have any of the following please bring them along:

A3 Drawing board with metric graph paper on it

2H pencils, rubber, ruler, callipers, dividers, masking tape

Cheap A4 copy paper to draw on
